Our very dear Friends and well Wishers,


Jesus the long-awaited Messiah and Saviour is here! "A child is born to us, a Son is given us." (Is.9:5)

Our Balwadi children in the villages are enjoying their classes. They are happy to get some snacks during their break time. One of our sisters visits the Balwadi children regularly. This year we bought some charts and teaching aids for the Balwadi children.

The children are interested to learn through the teaching aids. The teachers have regular meetings in our center to learn more skills for teaching and taking care of the little children in the villages. The "Self Help Groups" of the women are quite awake and are empowered by the efforts made by our sisters in the villages through training programmes.
